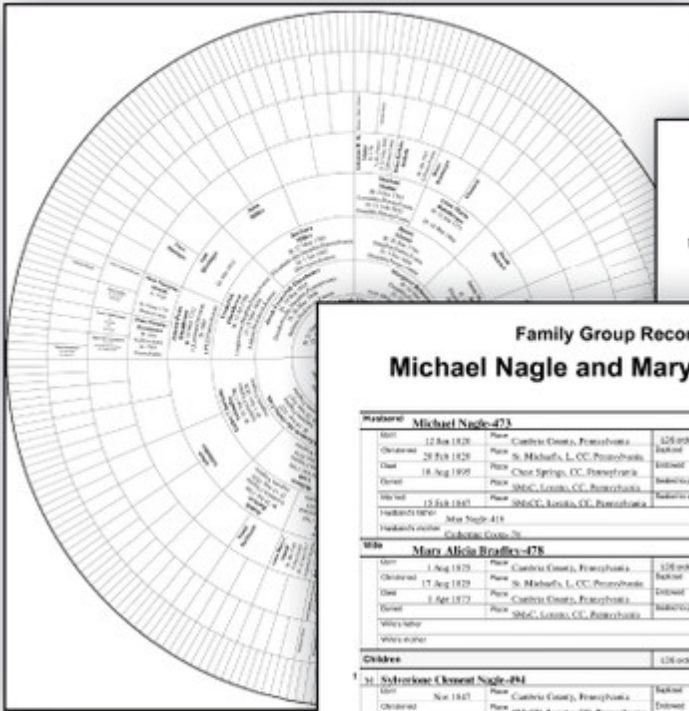

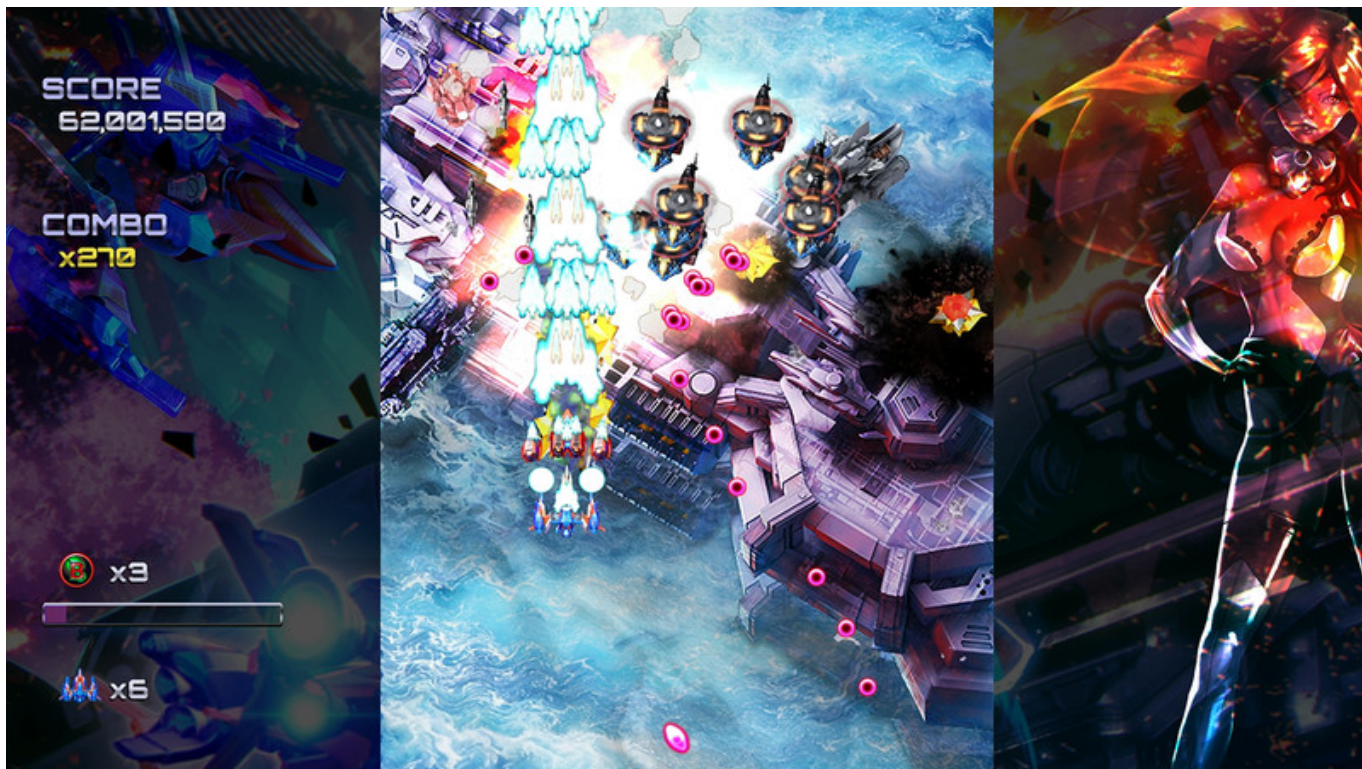

Thumbs up from me. Just wanted to get a quick review in, for those who might be one the fence.. I'm so happy to find this on Steam!

I've had ISO images of the original CDs for years, but of course they don't work in Windows anymore. However, this Steam version works perfectly fine in full-screen on Windows 10 1903 running on all current hardware. No sound or visual glitches whatsoever. It's well worth the \$6 I paid.

Now it's time to go experience the stories of the Lexington, Jericho, and Persephone all over again!. A good game, with a good story, and good characters. The characters are all nicely written and done. The story, while a little confusing, is excellent and I've gotten so attached to this game, as a whole. This game is a fresh concept, at least in my eyes, and I love how it was executed. All of the episodes currently out are amazing. I even get Hello Charlotte vibes in my everyday life, but I don't mind, because that just shows what a lasting effect it had on me! I love this game, this series, and everything in it, even the body horror monstrosities. Personally, I would rank it at a 9+ out of 10!. Great game !!! Underneath Clutch's snarly, indie, East Euro exterior beats the heart of a very average racer that gets repetitive quickly. Sure, the races take place in a zombie-plagued future, but your tasks are essentially the same as in every other arcade racer out there, just with a "STALKER-ish" paint job. There's fixed checkpoint races, (semi-) random checkpoint races, demolition derbies, "ram the other racer" races, and variations on these themes. The fact that you're mowing down zombies between point A and point B is kind of exciting at first, but then you realize that there's far better arcade racers out there (say, the first GRID) and far better mow-the-peds-down racers out there (the old, but still vital, Carmageddon). If you absolutely have to motor over zombies I'd recommend the top-down "Zombie Driver", which, while still an indie eyesore, gives you actual missions and guns. Clutch: 2/5 stars.. one of the most challenging games ever !!!

You can't pickup anything unless you have an objective to pick it up and you cant just hit escape to exit a dialog, you have to select "cancel" from the menu and nobody has time for that. Lame.. You get what you paid for, 5K achievements at minimum price. If you're an achievement hunter looking to increase the number of achievements on your profile showcase, then I highly recommend buying this. Else don't waste your money. This is not a game, it's just a way of distributing achievements.

Firstly, well done and please keep up the good work with this project. So far I have thoroughly enjoyed the difficulty involved with simply surviving the maps.

As someone with limited experience in top down shooters, I am quite literally a sitting target for the enemy and so I have to rely on grinding quests, mining and potentially crafting in order to remain strong enough to compete in combat with opponents even 5 levels below me (Tech level permitting). Its a matter of who kills who first, fight/flight and strafing don't seem a viable option for me yet, so I must play cautiously. Other players may of course have the knack to dodge fire and strafe while still being able to hit their targets :P

I have reached a point where I am attempting to attain honourable with The Syndicate in order to purchase one of their vessels and I am glad that there are such things as reputation and sufficient reason to pursue it.

While the main quest only lasted a matter of minutes before I was seemingly left alone by my contact in control of this vessel and without much direction. Some might view this as being left to their own devices and therefore, unrestricted by a storyline. I happily give it a 6/10 for now, with many hours of free-roaming fun ahead.

Ante.. The end of this was amazing, stick with it. I don't want to be too negative here, because this is the first ever game, from a small indie developer, and so I will tick the 'recommend' box... but there are a number of issues with how the game has been marketed, that need addressing. This game should have been released as 'Early Access' because 80% of the features listed in the description, are not present at this time.

-The trailer shows hotdogs alongside the burgers and the Steam description states 'cook burgers, hotdogs and MUCH MORE' The only food items in the current version of the game are burgers. Burgers, burgers and more burgers.

-The Steam description states 'Compete with friends' which in itself, isn't claiming to be multiplayer, but it's certainly verging on implying such functionality.

-Steam description states 'create your own journey in your path' There are no 'choices' to be made. I thought there might have been options to create your own burger recipes, or hell, at least to name your Burger Van but no.

-The trailer uses the term 'Flip Burgers' and the Steam description ends on the line 'Keep on Flippin' There is no 'flipping' of the burgers, they simply cook when on the grill. Yes, this might seem quite an insignificant issue, but when the game is literally cooking burgers, I expect to see this functionality in place, especially given the implications within the trailer and description.

-Although the Career mode is missing, the game description is at least upfront about this part and states 'coming soon'

The game is also lacking another key feature a menu! There is no way to edit graphics, sounds, position, music or even to exit the game properly. The only way to exit is to open the Steam app in your HMD and close that way, which causes a number of problems with Steam, which then has to be re-started before the game can be launched again.

All this being said, I only paid \$35.20 for the game at launch and so as long as the Devs are committed to improving & updating the game, I won't feel cheated.

Nevertheless you could try. 30min is enough to evaluate and claim refund.. Alright, so first of all, I enjoyed this game! It was a fun little story about a person (pick your gender) who happens to be a half breed of the old gods from Lovecraftian lore that needs to amass an army to destroy Innsmouth. However this game does it in a Visual Novel type presentation that also happens to be an RPG, cause you have a few stats here and there that affect the game. Also there are multiple branching paths you can take depending on your choices throughout the game. You can tell a lot of time and thought was put into the design of the overall product and how it functions. Also the humor reminds me a lot of the sarcastic, trope ignoring, 4th wall breaking, pop

culture referencing, snarky humor you'd find in a game like The Bard's Tale, and I enjoyed that quite a bit actually. It's what kept me playing to the end.

That being said, this game isn't going to appeal to everyone. The humor type alone may put off some people, while amusing others. Also you have to get past the art. The way it's presented is with photo backdrops with artistic renditions of the characters that are talking. The art and characters aren't bad though, you can just tell it's done with multiple artists with different art styles (which strangely works for the type of quirky game this is). This can be jarring at first but I was able to quickly look past it.

Overall I was looking for a fun story with Cthulhu/Old Gods type mythos in it, and I got it! Also the price point is cheap enough that even if it slightly piques your interest in it you should go for it!

TL;DR

Fun Visual Novel/RPG Hybrid game with quirky Bard's Tale type humor which you may love or not that suggests multiple plays due to branching story paths. Also if you can get over the inconsistent art style and photo backgrounds and see the charm in it then you'll enjoy it. There are worse ways to spend \$5.. This one is a hard thumbs-down to give, because this is not a bad game (in fact, it's a good one). My main argument against this one is, being a sequel to the original, all you're really getting that's new is one playable character and maybe a minor gameplay tweak or two. So you can pay \$5 for a good bargain-bin-priced fighting game or pay \$20 for the same game with one additional playable character. While I like the game so far and on its own merits it's good, the fact that it's a sequel that is 99% like the first one-and costs 2-3 times as much-is why I go thumbs down, It's a good game and offers plenty of good anime-style fanservice, but because of the original I can't recommend this one over the first game. If, however, you can somehow get this on a sale/promotion for \$10 or less (normally it's \$20), then go for it.. Loved this game when it first came out, but cannot recommend it now. It is ruined by all the Stardock crap you have to go through in order to even just open it.

Don't bother purchasing this, but it's still worth getting if you can work around the account creation aspect... if you know what I mean.. When spore came out a long time ago on CD it was a fun game for me. When I saw it available on steam I was happy to get it again. It's fun creative out look to creatures you form, survive and evolve to go as long as you can with out falling is very interesting.
